The Northeast Vintage Kart Promoter's Cup Series

Sandy Hook, MD May 20-21 • Avon, NY July 27-29 • Oreville, PA Sept 15-16
Cuddebackville, NY Oct 6-7

What is the series and how will it work?

It is a 4 event series which uses the best 3 out of 4 race events to track points from the season opener at Sandy Hook, to the end of season at Cuddebackville.

Series participation will be constituted by a minimum attendance of two events in the same class. At the last event, points will be totaled with separate awards being presented for "The Northeast Vintage Kart Promoter's Cup Series".

In addition to competitive awards that are based on cumulative points there will also be a "Sportsmanship Award" and a "Top Team Award". These awards will be presented based on merit that is judged collectively by the "Series" Promoters.

There is no extra charge for participating in the "Promoters Cup Series". For this 2017 season, The Northeast Vintage Kart Promoters have selected 5 classes eligible for participation in the Series.

8.2	Rear
Yamaha	Stock Appearing (up to 1.25" axle)
6.1	American (Fan Cooled) Sidewinder (1" axle) (Include 6.1 "Straight Axle" Sidewinder)
8.2	American (Fan Cooled) Sidewinder (1" axle) (Include 8.2 "Straight Axle" Sidewinder also Include 6.1 Foreign Engines)

• All 4 events are VKA and subject to VKA rules.

• The 4 events, and the collective event, "The Northeast Vintage Kart Promoter's Cup Series", will be conducted keeping in mind the core VKA vision. That is, to grow Vintage Kart participation, to further the acquisition, preservation, and restoration of Vintage Go-Karts, and all in a safety minded environment.

• All 4 events remain independent and will be conducted as usual. Class structure, Kart Show, scoring, awards, etc, will all, basically, remain the same as in previous years. Again, each event is independent and has its own awards ceremony that may also include additional classes not tracked by the Promoter's Series. For more information regarding individual events, please refer to the individual event flyers for each track.

• The Mission of the "Promoter's Series"...
The ultimate goal is to create an atmosphere that will add incentives and increase the participation of "Vintage Karters" at all events.

The Series allows promoters to recognize not only the success of an individual or group on a particular day but also allows recognition of accomplishments across the entire season. The Series, by means of point tracking, recognizes consistency in participation, consistency in engineering, and consistency in driving.

• Additional Information
Transponders will be used and supplied at all events.

"Tier I" and "Tier II" classes will all have 3 heat races.
(Time constraints could make some adjustment necessary)

The point system used for scored classes will be Motocross Scoring.

"Tier II" Participants at all 4 events will have their own (non-scored) flagged heats. Grid position will be left to the discretion and comfort level of the individual karters.
